Service Projects

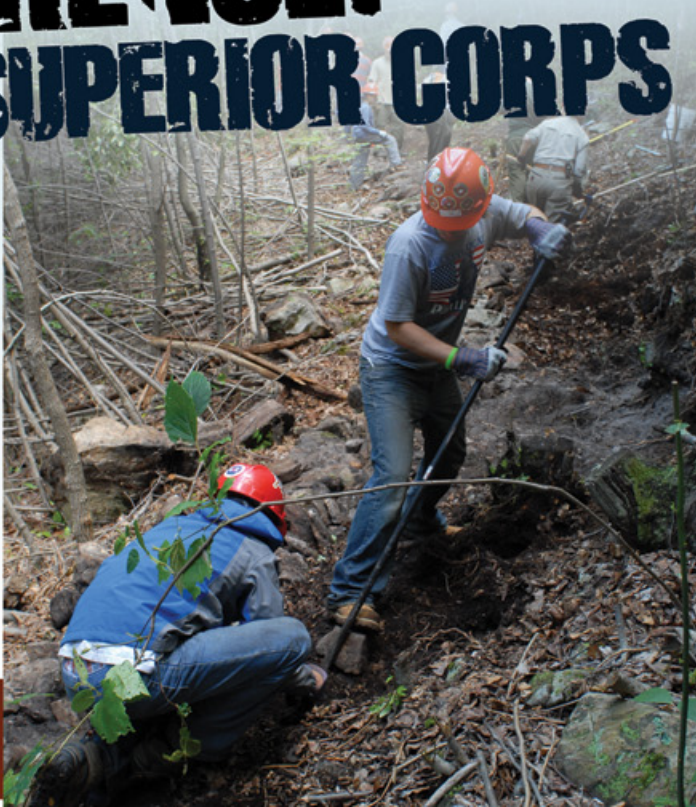
There are at least five service projects that need to be completed on the Hiawatha National Forest. The North Country Trail needs new trail markers and vegetation moved away from the foot trail. Recently, there was a wildfire at Ready Lake. We need to repair a fire line and dozer trail, replant grass so the vegetation can grow once more. Both Grand Island Recreational Area and the Big Island Wilderness Area need invasive species of harmful vegetation removed. It is up to us to reshape some trails damaged by ATV use and close trails by blocking them with trees. Finally, there are local fish habitats that need to be restored, most particularly birthing places.

Camp Hiawatha

Our base camp is Camp Hiawatha in Michigan's Upper Peninsula within the Hiawatha National Forest. It has been open for forty-three years with Scouts coming from as far away as Sault Ste. Marie, Canada; Alpena, Michigan; and LaCrosse, Wisconsin. This camp offers a beautiful lakeside view along with forested trails. We have seven campsites for sleeping areas, a shower house and service building for cooking meals.
